I know you have more pressing matters than who gets Captain — I watch the news — but I could use any extra luck you can toss my way.

#2 - What I Was Born to Do

'Cause I worked my whole life to lead Truman High to Nationals. It's all I wanted since I was a kid.

(sings:)

I WAS IN THE STANDS
ROOTING FOR OUR TEAM
WHEN I SAW THE BUCCANEERS CHEER FOR THE FIRST TIME —
STANDING ON THEIR HANDS,
EVERY MOVE EXTREME,
I LOOKED AROUND: DO THESE PEOPLE SEE WHAT I SEE?

I FEEL LIKE I'M A PART OF IT ALL FOR THE FIRST TIME

AND IF I EVER FALL (NO!)
I KNOW MY SQUAD IS THERE
CUZ I'VE GOT THE BUCCANEERS HERE BEHIND ME —

ENSEMBLE

THESE TRUMAN GIRLS ARE SUPERHUMAN GIRLS

I'M KYLAR – FROM TYLER – MY REAL NAME IS INEZ.
BUT SKYLAR SAID TO CHANGE IT AND I DO WHAT SKYLAR SAYS!

BRIDGET

MY NAME IS BRIDGET!
I ROCK THE PARROT HEAD!
IT'S HOT IN HERE AND KINDA SMELLS
LIKE SOMEONE WET THE BED. (GROSS!)

STEVEN

WHAT'S UP, MY NAME IS STEVEN

I'M SO

STEVEN & TRUMAN MEN

HANDSOME IT HURTS!

STEVEN

DON'T NEED AN UMB-AH-RELLA

I STAND UNDER MINISKIRTS! (WHUUUUT?)

YEAH, I'M A BOSS, I DON'T CARE WHAT THE HATERS SAY.

TRUMAN MEN

HOW MANY DUDES CAN SAY THEY PICK UP

GIRLS ALL DAY?

STEVEN

LOVE YOU!

CAMPBELL

LOVE YOU MORE!

Skylar holds a folded sheet of paper. Members of the Truman squad gather around.

SKYLAR

All right! The ballots are IN. To celebrate the beginning of summer, I choose myself to read the results. Campbell, you look a little nervous.

CAMPBELL

Just tell us already.

SKYLAR

Someone's whole lifetime of dreams could get shattered in a few short seconds.

CAMPBELL

Skylar! God!

SKYLAR

Ahem. So our new Captain is

Kylar makes a drumroll sound.

Stop it.

KYLAR

Sorry.

SKYLAR

It's Campbell.

Oh my God!

General celebration.

STEVEN

Baby, congratulations!

CAMPBELL

Thank you all for trusting me. I promise I'll bring us to Nationals, and we're taking the trophy this year!

(to Skylar)

Skylar, I'm sorry. I know you wanted to be Captain.

SKYLAR

(taking the high road)

On the bright side this proves this isn't a popularity contest. You'll do great, girl.

Two Goth kids enter.

GOTH GIRL

(dourly)

Oh yay. Cheerleader tryouts are tonight. Pick me.

GOTH GUY

No pick me. I'm dying to be that grievously plastic.

GOTH GIRL

Heinously weird.

GOTH GUY

Even mocking cheerleaders cannot hide the emptiness in my soul.

CAMPBELL

Hey!

YOU NEVER MET ME FACE TO FACE

IF YOU THINK CHEERLEADERS ARE A WASTE OF SPACE -

WE WORK AND WE FIGHT AND WE TRAIN AND HUSTLE,

WE GET MANI-PEDIS BUT WE'RE MADE OF MUSCLE.

WE GOT ONE SHOT THAT WE WORK ALL YEAR FOR.

WE GOT MORE BALLS THAN THE TEAM WE CHEER FOR.

NATIONALS IS GETTING CLOSER BY THE MINUTE-

CAMPBELL & TRUMAN SQUAD

LAST YEAR WE TOOK BRONZE, THIS YEAR WE'RE GONNA WIN IT! BRING IT!

(WITH TRUMAN ECHOES)

COUNTING DOWN THE DAYS (HEY!)

MAKING NEW ROUTINES (HO!)

TRYING OUT A TUMBLING PASS FOR THE FIRST TIME-

CALLING ALL THE PLAYS (HEY!)

HERE BEHIND THE SCENES (HO!) -

I LOOK AROUND, DO THESE PEOPLE SEE WHAT I SEE? (I SEE)

TRUMAN SQUAD

THESE TRUMAN GIRLS

ARE SUPERHUMAN GIRLS

WE'VE GOT THE SPIRIT AND WE'LL SEE IT THROUGH.

WE GLADLY PAY OUR DUES

WITH EVERY SPRAIN AND BRUISE

WE WILL LEAVE IT ALL ON THE FLOOR.

WE WILL LEAVE IT ALL. LEAVE IT ALL.

FULL ENSEMBLE

GO, GO, LET'S GO!

CAMPBELL

FULL ENSEMBLE

TRUMAN HIGH!

CAMPBELL

C'MON PICK UP THE PACE! I HEAR DESTINY CALLING!

ENSEMBLE

GO, GO, LET'S GO!

CAMPBELL

ООНННННННН!

YOU CANNOT BE AFRAID TO FALL DOWN AND WORK THROUGH IT!
OOHHHHHHHH!

SKYLAR, KYLAR, EVA, BRIDGET, NAUTICA

THESE TRUMAN GIRLS ARE SUPERHUMAN GIRLS—OH, THESE TRUMAN GIRLS ARE SUPERHUMAN GIRLS

CAMPBELL

'CAUSE THIS IS WHAT WE'RE BORN TO DO, SO LET'S DO IT!

#2a - School's Out

SCENE TWO GYM — TRYOUT SEQUENCE

Bell. School's out!

STEVEN

(offering flowers)

Hey baby, I got you these. They're fake, so they'll last forever. Like my love.

(noticing her)

Baby, you there?

CAMPBELL

Oh. Sorry, I'm prepping for tryouts in my head. And for our routine for Cheer Camp. And designs for the new uniforms. And fundraising to get us to Regionals. And then Nationals —

STEVEN

(soothingly)

Hey, hey — stop trippin'.

#2b - Happy Kitties

I know what you need.

(nuzzling her)

HAPPY KITTIES.

CAMPBELL

(smiling, a bit)

SLEEPY PUPPIES.

STEVEN

BABY DUCKIES.

CAMPBELL

(nuzzling him)

SPARKLE PONIES.

Skylar stares at them.

SKYLAR

I'm sorry - what WAS that?

STEVEN

Oh - when Campbell or I feel bad, one of us says, "Happy kitties" -

- and the other one says

STEVEN & CAMPBELL

"Sleepy puppies"

STEVEN

and the other one says "Baby duckies"

CAMPBELL

and the other one says "Sparkle ponies" -

STEVEN

And then we feel better.

They smile lovingly.

SKYLAR

Well, it grosses me out.

BRIDGET

I think it's sweet. It makes me all googly inside. I don't know why.

SKYLAR

Bridget, meet Puberty. Puberty, this is Bridget.

(as though Puberty has run away)

Puberty? Puberty, don't go. Bridget needs you.

CAMPBELL

All right, focus, everyone, tryouts are about to start. The applicants are filling out their cards, and they'll hand them in to —

(noticing Skylar, who's in a reverie)

Skylar, what are you doing?

#3 - Tryouts

SKYLAR

I'm savoring the moment. I'll be with you in a sec. (purely)

I REMEMBER MY FIRST TRYOUTS
AND MY SECOND AND THIRD, TOO,
ALL THE FEAR AND HOLY HELL
THE JUDGES PUT ME THROUGH.

(SKYLAR)

I FELT SO BELITTLED —

MAN, THEY PUT ME ON THE RACK,

AND NOW THAT I'M A SENIOR

THIS IS MY CHANCE TO GIVE BACK!

I'LL UPHOLD THE GREAT TRADITION
WITH THESE YOUNG LIVES ON MY WATCH.
LET'S SET THE STAGE,
I'VE COME OF AGE
TO BE A RAGING CASTRATING
BEE-YOTCH—
BEEEE-YOOOOTCH!

Bridget is center stage, at the end of her tryout.

BRIDGET

So as you know I portrayed our mascot, Bucky the Parrot, for three years — and I would love to graduate to cheerleader.

(a sudden enthusiastic cheer)

S-P-I-R-T! What does that spell?

SKYLAR

(considering)

"Spirt." It spells "spirt."

CAMPBELL

Thank you, Bridget, that was a great tryout.

BRIDGET

(in one breath)

My Mom said if I don't get cheerleader, it'll be the first in a cascading series of disappointments that'll end with me as a bitter, chain-smoking divorcee living in an unfurnished condo in Fresno.

(breath)

No pressure.

CAMPBELL

Excuse us a sec.

BRIDGET

(in a robot voice)

Isolation - booth - "on."

Bridget turns as the group leans in to confer.

CAMPBELL

I wish we were only judging on school spirit, but I'm afraid she has to be Bucky the Parrot for the fourth year in a row. We need to let her down easy.

SKYLAR

(gravely)

Campbell - I got this.

CAMPBELL

Be. Nice.

SKYLAR

I don't like what you're suggesting. It says more about you than it does about me. Watch and learn, Campbell.

(to Bridget, over a ballady underscore:)

Honey, I have some bad news. We both know what it is, so there's no point in me saying it, is there?

BRIDGET

I guess not.

SKYLAR

Bridget, don't keep the pain inside. You're not alone. Share your feelings with someone you trust, someone who cares about you.

In a reverie, Bridget steps forward and takes the stage for her show-stopping ballad:

BRIDGET

(sings)

SOMEHOW I'LL FIND THE STRENGTH INSIDE ME,

SKYLAR

I'm sorry, that's all the time we have for today. Namaste.

Transit to Eva's audition. Campbell coaches her into a basket toss.

CAMPBELL

Okay Eva — remember, keep your weight through your arms, stand up fast, squeeze through your core and ride the basket to the top

STEVEN

And one, two...

Eva goes up into a simple basket toss, landing neatly.

There you go!

EVA

(rushing to Campbell)

Oh my gosh, I always dreamed about how that would feel.

CAMPBELL

You were flying, Eva.

EVA

Thank you — thank you, that was so neat.

(fretting suddenly)

But I totally screwed up -

CAMPBELL

No -

EVA

I landed a bit crooked maybe. I was nervous.

CAMPBELL

You did really well.

EVA

(blushing)

Thanks. You know I've watched you my whole life from my window. Practicing in your yard.

CAMPBELL

We're neighbors. I've known her since she was a little baby.

EVA

She's my inspiration. All of you are. I think you're all so amazing. God, does that sound dorky?

STEVEN

No -

KYLAR

No -

SKYLAR

Of course not, I think we're amazing, too.

EVA

Even if I don't make it on the squad, I'll never forget this. And if I do — I'll do anything to get Truman to Nationals. Thanks, everybody.

She exits, shyly.

KYLAR

(smitten with Eva)

I want to carry her in my purse like a Shih Tzu.

CAMPBELL

Well, she may lack cheersperience, but my gut tells me that Eva's our best shot in that position.

SKYLAR

But she's never cheered before. She wasn't even on J.V.

CAMPBELL

She'll fly the highest, she seems like a hard worker — did you see the devotion in her eyes?

SKYLAR

That's adorable but I don't know that she has "star quality."

CAMPBELL

Well, none of us did when we first started.

(a moment)

Okay, you did.

SKYLAR

I'll give in 'cause you're the boss. But don't forget that Cheer Camp starts in twenty days. If Truman doesn't win the Spirit Stick at the finale, you may never want to show your face in public for-like-ever.

CAMPBELL

God! The pressure's bad enough!

#4 - One Perfect Moment

SKYLAR

But look, our summer has begun — I think it's time to celebrate. C'mon, let's hit the food court.

A hubbub as Steven, Kylar and Skylar head off:

STEVEN

(overlap)

Curly fries! And Orange Julius! What heaven.

KYLAR

(overlap)

Can we make a stop at Skanky Couture? Pretty please?

SKYLAR

(overlap)

I'm sorta glad to NOT be Captain.

They're gone. Campbell is alone.

CAMPBELL

I'M NOT FREAKING OUT,
I'M REALLY OKAY—
I'M TOTALLY CHILL
OR I WILL BE SOMEDAY.
'CAUSE I'M SO NEAR THE TOP,
BUT THERE'S SO MANY MOUNTAINS TO CLIMB.

THERE ARE PLANS TO BE PLANNED,
DRILLS TO BE DRILLED,
CAUSE THIS DREAM THAT I DREAMED
IS BECOMING FULFILLED,
AND I PLAN TO ENJOY IT
BUT RIGHT NOW, I DON'T HAVE THE TIME.

FADE IN ON CAMPBELL
AN AVERAGE TEENAGER, ALMOST GROWN—
CLOSE UP ON AVERAGE GRADES
FROM THE AVERAGE LIFE SHE'S KNOWN.
NOW ZOOM IN THE LENS ON THE REST OF HER FRIENDS
AS SHE STAYS ALONE
DOING THE WORK. GETTING IT RIGHT.
CUZ I KNOW
WE'LL HAVE TO BE PRACTICALLY PERFECT
SO I'LL GO

ABOVE AND BEYOND AND PULL THROUGH.

(CAMPBELL)

THIS I CAN DO.

ALL THAT I'M ASKING IS ONE PERFECT MOMENT IN TIME.

I'M SEVENTEEN.

THERE ARE SO MANY THINGS THAT I CAN'T CONTROL.

IF I START TO FREAK OR FEEL WEAK I FOCUS ON JUST ONE GOAL.

TURN DOWN THE PANIC, ATTACK THIS ROUTINE

LIKE IT OWNS MY SOUL!

TURN UP THE MUSIC

SO LOUD THAT IT SWALLOWS US WHOLE—

AND THEN THERE WE ARE,

WE BURN LIKE A STAR,

WE'RE SAFE INSIDE THE WORLD WE KNOW—

THEN SUDDENLY I'M

IN PREP FOR THE CLIMB AND HERE I GO!

HIGH IN THE AIR

THERE IS A MOMENT JUST BEFORE YOU START TO FALL—

LIVE IN THAT ONE MOMENT.

I KNOW

THAT IF I CAN JUST STICK THE LANDING, THEN I'LL KNOW

111211122101011

THAT SOMEHOW, MY LIFE WILL BE FINE -

AND I'LL GO

THROUGH THE REST OF MY LIFE UNDERSTANDING

WHAT IT FEELS LIKE TO SHINE.

THE FUTURE'S FULL OF MYSTERIES

SO PLEASE LET THIS BE MINE -

MY ONE PERFECT MOMENT IN TIME.

SCENE THREE CHEER CAMP

The Truman squad is practicing.

#5 - Cheer Camp

TRUMAN SQUAD

TRU-MAN!

TRU-MAN!

TRU-MAN!

TRU-MAN!

T-R-U M-A-N!

T-R-U M-A-N!

WE'RE TRU! (SOUL-SHAKIN'!)

TRU! (PRIZE-TAKIN'!)

HISTORY IN THE MAKIN'!

TRUMAN'S WHAT? (SOUL-SHAKIN'!)

TRUMAN'S WHAT? (GROUND-BREAKIN'!)

THIS IS WHAT? (PRIZE-TAKIN'!)

HISTORY IN THE MAKIN'!

TRUMAN'S WHAT? (SOUL-SHAKIN'!)

TRUMAN'S WHAT? (GROUND-BREAKIN'!)

SKYLAR

C'mon Eva, hit it!

TRUMAN SQUAD

TRU (GROUND-BREAKIN')

LET'S GO,

TRU! (PRIZE-TAKIN'!

HISTORY IN THE MAKIN'.)

SUPER HUMAN TRUMAN HIGH!

RECORDED VOICE

LEGENDARY!

Eva blows a stunt.

WHITT

You suck!

All right, Eva, you've gotta hit it next time.

Eva moves aside, upset. Skylar and Kylar march to Campbell.

KYLAR

If we were called "bummerleaders," Eva would be perfect for the squad.

SKYLAR

(still held up in the air in an extension)

That girl is a capital F-A-Y-L "fail."

(to the guys)

Down.

(they lower her to the ground)

We have fifteen minutes until the final presentation. Fif. Teen. This isn't some junior high pep assembly. This is life and death. This is Cheer Camp.

CAMPBELL

Skylar, I'll handle it, and hey, while I'm doing that, somebody needs to put Bitter Bitch Barbie back in her box.

(to all)

Take a quick break, everyone. We're on in — fourteen.

Bridget approaches.

BRIDGET

Just FYI, I know Eva's whole part in the routine, just in case.

CAMPBELL

Good to know, Bridget. Thank you.

Bridget exits as Campbell goes to Eva.

Hey — Eva. What's the story?

EVA

(tears of frustration)

I'm never gonna get that stunt right. I should just quit now.

CAMPBELL

Excuse me, but being a cheerleader is like being a Marine. You signed your life away.

EVA

But I'm letting everybody down.

CAMPBELL

You're only letting us down if you give up. I have faith in you, even if you don't. I was about to name you my Sophomore Spirit Leader.

EVA

What's that?

CAMPBELL

Well, that puts you in my line of succession. If I can't fulfil my duties, then Skylar becomes Captain. And if Skylar falls out, then Captain goes to Kylar. And after her, to my trusted Sophomore Spirit Leader — you.

EVA

Really? I'm just so scared all the time.

#6 - What I Was Born to Do (Reprise)

CAMPBELL

Look — I'm not your Captain so much as your friend. And we can help each other change beyond what we can even dream.

The song builds as we move to Truman's final Cheer Camp performance.

LET'S GO

WE BOTH HAVE WHAT IT TAKES,

TAKE A BREATH AND LET'S WIN IT-

OH!

THERE'S NO ROOM FOR MISTAKES,

ANNOUNCER

BRIDGET

(removing her parrot head)

They did it! I feel like a proud Cheer Mom. Campbell sure pulled it off! The winner of the Spirit Stick has placed first at Nationals for the last six years. Now I don't wanna jinx anything, but I think that Campbell's got it in the bag!

Whistle! The Truman squad celebrates with a triumphant chant:

SCENE FOUR CAMPBELL'S ROOM

Campbell is with Eva, Kylar and Skylar. She holds a letter, shocked.

CAMPBELL

Omigod.

EVA

What's the matter?

CAMPBELL

This letter came for me — it can't be possible.

SKYLAR

What are you talking about?

(reading the letter:)

"Dear Campbell Davis, due to the redist - redist - " Sorry, that's a really big word.

CAMPBELL

"Redistricting -"

SKYLAR

Sometimes being pretty is enough.

CAMPBELL

(grabs the letter, hands it to Eva)

YOU read it!

EVA

"Due to the redistricting of school district lines in District Seven, we wish to inform you that based on your home address, you are hereby reassigned to Jackson High School for the upcoming school year."

They all look at each other, shocked.

KYLAR

Jackson High School?

CAMPBELL

Jackson High School. Of all the schools: THAT one. And classes start in two weeks! This can't be real.

EVA

What does this mean?

Well, Eva, you live right next door — so this means, if this is true, which it could not possibly be, but if it did happen to be true, which it is not, then that means — we're going to Jackson next year. And Skylar's the captain. But that's not happening! It's not!

EVA

(meekly)

I got a letter today that says I'm going back to Truman.

CAMPBELL

You did? Well, see? A mistake!

SKYLAR

Good thing. That Jackson school is scary as S-H on the I-T.

KYLAR

They don't even have a squad.

SKYLAR

No cheerleading squad? What's the point of having a SCHOOL?

KYLAR

The legends of old say that five years ago the Jackson cheerleaders were a rough group of girls. Like Hell's Angels, but cheerleaders. At the Cornucopia dance they started a schoolwide riot and held a gaggle of cafeteria ladies in a three-day hostage stand-off. And so the Jackson cheerleading program was cancelled until the End of Days.

Campbell goes to her computer and types.

CAMPBELL

Well I know ONE way to find out what's going on — We'll just Google "redistricting" and "unfair" and "school district lines" and ...

#6b – Google

She hits a button. Projected behind her is a map of Campbell's neighborhood, with a dotted line cutting the neighborhood in half — Eva and Campbell's house on the same side of the line.

The line redraws itself, neatly cutting Campbell's house into the new district.

A musical sting.

Time passes. Steven is with Campbell.

#6c - Perfect Moment (Reprise)

STEVEN

Baby? You okay?

CAMPBELL

(working very hard to stay positive)

Oh yeah. None of the petitions worked and neither did crying in front of the school board. And my parents refused to sell their house and move. But you know what I learned? When life hands you a lemon, you — you know — work really hard to convince yourself it's not a lemon.

A car horn beeps offstage.

STEVEN

I'm glad you're feeling so perky, baby.

CAMPBELL

I mean, lots of people would love a fresh start in their lives. Now that I'm not tied down to cheerleading, I can do anything I want.

STEVEN

You're awesome. Look — I gotta get to practice. Wait'll you see the new pyramid we're working on. You're gonna freak.

He kisses her and exits. Campbell is alone.

CAMPBELL

SMILING-

AS HE GOES TO PRACTICE WITHOUT ME.

I'M SMILING-

THEY'RE DOING JUST FINE ON THEIR OWN.

I'M PSYCHED FOR

THIS SUDDEN EXCITING NEW CHAPTER -

OKAY, THAT'S A LIE.

I DON'T WANT TO LEAVE,
I DON'T WANT TO CHANGE,
I DON'T UNDERSTAND,
I WANT MY OLD LIFE BACK—
I'LL NEVER GET TO FLY—

GOODBYE, PERFECT MOMENT, GOODBYE.

#7 - Do Your Own Thing

A metal detector onstage. Campbell arrives at school among a line of students passing through but she's the only one who sets it off.

CAMPBELL

Oh God, I didn't know - uh, hang on -

STUDENTS

MOVE!

MOVE!

TWIG

WELCOME TO JACKSON!

GIRLS

NO HE DIDN'T!

BOYS

MOVE!

TWIG & CAMERON

WELCOME TO JACKSON!

GIRLS

HE COULD GET IT!

BOYS

MOVE!

Campbell tries to hail passing students.

CAMPBELL

EXCUSE ME THEY TOLD ME I NEED A -

STUDENTS

MOVE!

CAMPBELL

HALLWAY PASS.

EXCUSE ME I'M TRYING TO FIND MY -

STUDENTS

MOVE!

HOMEROOM CLASS.

I'M LOOK IN FOR SOMEONE TO FOLLOW SO I KNOW MY WAY, BUT EVERYONE'S GOING THEIR OWN WAY NOW.

CAN SOMEBODY ANYBODY SHOW ME AROUND?

STUDENTS

DON'T FOLLOW ME (HEY!)

WHY YOU ON TOP OF ME,

LEAVE ME ALONE, DO YOUR OWN THING! (HO!)

DO YOUR OWN THING! (HEY!)

COMIN THROUGH! (HEY!)

I AIN'T FOLLOWIN YOU DO

WHAT YOU GOTTA DO DO YOUR OWN THING! (HO!)

DO YOUR OWN THING! (HEY!)

CRAP IT'S TIME FOR CLASS.

A bell rings, and the students assemble.

TEACHER'S VOICE

Class, please welcome a new transfer student from Truman High. Please give a warm Jackson welcome to — uh, what's your name — Campbell?

CAMPBELL

Campbell.

CAMERON

Like the soup?

TWIG

Lookin' hot, Cream of Mushroom!

Bridget pops up and waves to Campbell.

BRIDGET

Campbell!

CAMPBELL

Bridget! Thank God!

BRIDGET

O-M-Goodness, you got redistricted too?

CAMPBELL

Can you believe this?

BRIDGET

I'm in heaven. I bet I've got until lunch at least before everyone sees I'm a spaz!

I wish Steven was here. I'm so not used to not fitting in.

BRIDGET

Oh, I've got lots of experience with not fitting in. Do you need some pointers?

CAMPBELL

I guess.

BRIDGET

Okay.

STEP ONE: TO BECOME INVISIBLE,
BOOKS UP, DE-ACCENTUATE THE PHYSICAL,
HEAD DOWN, USE ONLY YOUR PERIPHERAL,
STICK WITH ME — WE'LL BE INDIVISIBLE!

CAMPBELL

THEY'VE TAKEN A HATCHET AND HACKED MY TEAM APART.

STUDENTS

MOVE!

CAMPBELL

THEY'VE TAKEN MY HIGH SCHOOL CAREER AND PRESSED RE-START.

I'M LOOKING FOR SOMEONE TO FOLLOW SO I KNOW MY WAY —

BRIDGET

BUT HEY WE'RE FINDING OUR OWN WAY NOW!
AND ISN'T THAT WHAT BEING YOUNG'S ALL ABOUT?
CHECK IT OUT NOW!

STUDENTS

DON'T FOLLOW ME!

BRIDGET

DON'T FOLLOW ANYBODY!

STUDENTS

WHY YOU ON TOP OF ME,
LEAVE ME ALONE, DO YOUR OWN THING!
DO YOUR OWN THING!

BRIDGET

EVERYONE HERE DOES THEIR OWN THING! WE'LL DO OUR OWN THING!

(BRIDGET)

C'MON, LET'S GO CRUNK IT IN THE PARKING LOT.

CAMPBELL

What?

Bridget demonstrates.

BRIDGET

YOU KNOW, CRUNKING, CRUNKING!

Twig passes by.

TWIG

(to Bridget)

Lookin' fine, baby.

BRIDGET

Sorry, what?

TWIG

I say you lookin' fine!

Bridget turns, delighted, to Campbell.

BRIDGET

Jinkies, no one has EVER SAID THAT to me before — with the exception of a hobo, once, and my youth pastor.

Randall enters and approaches Cameron.

RANDALL

WHAT'S UP MAN?

CAMERON

YO, WHAT IT DO, KID? YOU GOT THE STUFF?

Randall slaps a small object in Cameron's hand.

RANDALL

CHOPPED AND SCREWED IT!

CAMERON

DAAAMN, I CAN'T WAIT TO USE IT!

RANDALL

I'M TELLING YOU, IT'S CRACK, SO DON'T LOSE IT!

CAMERON

CHECK IT OUT - IT'S THE CUTE CAMPBELL'S SOUP KID!

CAMPBELL

CAMPBELL.

RANDALL

I'M SORRY, WHO'S THIS?

CAMPBELL

ARE YOU GUYS SELLING CRACK?!

RANDALL

DON'T BE STUPID, DUDE, IT'S A MEMORY STICK FULL OF MUSIC!

CAMPBELL

UCHH, I'M SORRY I'M SUCH A DOOFUS—
I'M JUMPIN' TO CONCLUSIONS, I'M USELESS.

RANDALL

HEY, IT'S COOL, YOU'RE NEW, YOU'LL GET THROUGH THIS.

BRIDGET & CAMPBELL

RIGHT NOW, WE STICK OUT LIKE TWO TOOTHPICKS!

CAMPBELL

I'M SO CONFUSED AS TO WHO'S IN WHOSE CLIQUE!

BRIDGET & CAMPBELL

WHERE ARE THE SURFER DUDES? WHO ARE THE COOL KIDS?

RANDALL

WE DON'T TRAVEL IN GROUPS, BUT THE TRUTH IS -

CAMERON & TWIG

WE DO HAVE A DANCE CREW, AND THEY'RE RUTHLESS -

Nautica enters and poses.

RECORDED VOICE

NAUTICA -

La Cienega, MTF transgendered, enters and poses.

LA CIENEGA -

Danielle enters between them.

DANIELLE

DANIELLE!

ENSEMBLE

CHECK IT OUT NOW!

The girls break into an amazing impromptu dance.

STUDENTS

MOVE! MOVE!

TWIG

MAKE WAY FOR THE CREW! LET EM THROUGH THEY CAN REALLY

ENSEMBLE

MOOOOOOOOVE!

TWIG

BREAK 'EM OFF SOMETHIN' NEW! BABY PROVE YOU CAN REALLY

ENSEMBLE

MOOOOOOOVE!

STUDENTS

OH, SNAP, YOU DO YOUR THING! GO DO YOUR THING!

DANIELLE

EV'RYBODY MOVE!

STUDENTS

OH, SNAP

YOU DO YOUR THING!

GO DO YOUR THING!

DANIELLE

EV'RYBODY MOVE!

STUDENTS

OH, SNAP!

YOU DO YOUR THING!

GO DO YOUR THING!

DANIELLE

YEAH, YEAH, YEAH!

#7a - The Day Goes By: Jackson

COMPANY

FIRST PERIOD SECOND PERIOD THIRD PERIOD -

CAMPBELL

LOOK AT THIS HIGH SCHOOL, EVERYONE'S FIGURED IT OUT -

COMPANY

FIFTH PERIOD, SIXTH, SEVENTH PERIOD -

CAMPBELL

NOW I DON'T KNOW WHAT TO DO.

COMPANY

FIRST PERIOD SECOND PERIOD THIRD PERIOD -

CAMPBELL

CAMPBELL BE NICE, JUST TRY TO BLEND IN WITH THE CROWD -

COMPANY

FIFTH PERIOD, SIXTH, SEVENTH PERIOD -

CAMPBELL

WOW. READY SET GO -

Bridget enters.

BRIDGET

Maybe you can expand your horizons. The competitive robotics team needs members, and oh! there's a top-secret mad-libs club but keep it on the D.L.

(Campbell is desolate.)

C'mon, Campbell, if we want to meet people and get them to like us, all we need to do is talk to them.

(to a passing male student)

Hi!

CARTER

Whassup, ho?

He continues walking.

BRIDGET

(to a passing female student)

Hi!

BROOKLYN

(friendly)

Yo, what it doin', slut?

She rolls past. Bridget turns brightly to Campbell.

BRIDGET

See? Two friends!

Randall overhears.

RANDALL

I'll be part of your social circle until you find a permanent one.

CAMPBELL

Oh – thank you.

BRIDGET

(counting)

Three friends.

CAMPBELL

Don't you have a social circle of your own?

RANDALL

That was harsh.

BRIDGET

And three minus one is two friends.

RANDALL

I'm just messing with you.

(extending his hand)

I'm Randall. I run with everybody.

CAMPBELL

Campbell. I didn't mean to sound -

RANDALL

You didn't. Look, if you need help navigating, come find me.

Cameron and Twig join them.

CAMERON

Well if it ain't Chicken Noodle!

(good-humored)

That's me — and this is my friend Bridget.

TWIG

(lusty)

Buh-ridget!

Bridget blushes.

CAMERON

Well, if y'all are good with my boy Randall, you're good -

(he sees Danielle approach)

you're good with me, at least.

DANIELLE

(friendly)

Hi Ladies. Welcome to the Thunderdome.

CAMPBELL

Hi, I'm Campbell. This is my friend Bridget.

DANIELLE

Danielle. And these're my girls Nautica and La Cienega.

LA CIENEGA

Hidey, hoe

NAUTICA

Pleased to meet your acquaintances.

Danielle turns to Bridget.

DANIELLE

So you're Bridget, huh?

BRIDGET

Though many days I wish it weren't so, yes.

NAUTICA

What you talking about, girl? We were just gagging over you.

BRIDGET

Is that a good thing?

LA CIENEGA

Mmm yes, Lady! We think your look is flawless. Where'd you get that top?

BRIDGET

Oh, gosh, it's my Mom's. Anything but a good poly blend tends to give me a rash.

DANIELLE

It's banging.

(to Campbell)

Don't you think?

CAMPBELL

Oh, yeah!

LA CIENEGA

Give us a 360.

Bridget turns in an awkward model pose.

Oooh, you are serving junk-in-the trunk REALNESS, honey.

TWIG

She ain't just got junk in the TRUNK — her whole car's messy from the rear bumper to the hood!

BRIDGET

I'm confused.

LA CIENEGA

Oh honey, I'd give anything for curves. I eat and eat and eat and I still look like a stick.

BRIDGET

Well, I eat and eat and I get chubby!

LA CIENEGA

Word.

She tries to give Bridget a complicated handshake, which Bridget fails smilingly, accidentally slapping La Cienega instead. A moment.

I love her!

Campbell steps in:

CAMPBELL

Can I just say — your dancing — I thought it was amazing.

DANIELLE

Why thank you. We work hard at it.

CAMPBELL

If you need someone else on your squad, I've got a ton of experience.

DANIELLE "Squad?" We're a "crew" - a hip-hop crew. **CAMPBELL** Oh, sorry - my people call it a "squad" -**CAMERON** Oh! **TWIG** Oh! Danielle winces and walks away. **NAUTICA** (to Campbell) Ooh, girl, that was a BIG hors d'oeuvre. LA CIENEGA A what? **NAUTICA** (puffing up proudly) It's a word I learned in French class. It means "screw-up." LA CIENEGA You mean "faux pas"? **NAUTICA** Oh, right. She and La Cienega crack up hard, then stop and turn to Campbell, deadpan. But yeah that was a BIG hors d'oeuvre. (La Cienega whacks her arm.) Eiffel Tower. (La Cienega whacks her again.) Faux pas. **CAMPBELL**

LA CIENEGA

Here's a clue: it started with "my" and continued with "people."

What did I say?

CAMPBELL

(rushing to Danielle)

Oh God, I didn't mean it the way it sounded. When I said "my people" I meant cheerleaders, not, you know, my people. I mean, it wouldn't take much for you guys to be an amazing squad.

#8 - We Ain't No Cheerleaders

DANIELLE

"Wouldn't take much?" Princess, what we do is nothing like "easy." (sings)

WE AIN'T NO CHEERLEADERS.

WE DON'T DO FAVORS FOR NO FOOTBALL TEAM.

DON'T GET IT TWISTED, THIS ISN'T YOUR SORORITY SISTERS

SINGIN, SWISHIN, "RAH RAH, SIS BOOM BAH." NUH UH!

NAUTICA & LA CIENEGA

"RAH RAH, BLA BLA BLA."

DANIELLE

SING IT WIT' ME IF YA FEEL ME.
WE DON'T GET DOWN WITH NO POM-POMS

NAUTICA & LA CIENEGA

HELL TO THE NAW!

DANIELLE

(With NAUTICA & LA CIENEGA)

WE BUST OUR ASS ON EVERY NEW ROUTINE.

WHEN WE ROLL (THROUGH) WITH OUR (CREW)

NO ONE CAN (DO) WHAT WE (DO), IT'S TRUE—

BUT WE WOULD STILL DO IT IF NO ONE WAS WATCHING.

NAUTICA

AND LET'S BE REAL, WHO COULD BLAME THEM FOR WATCHING?

DANIELLE

WHEN THE D.J. PLAYS OUR SONG
AND IT ALL GOES DOWN AS PLANNED
WE'RE IN THE POCKET, WE'RE POPPIN' AND LOCKIN'
YOU PROB'LY GO SHOPPIN'
WITH YOUR DADDY'S CREDIT CARD IN YOUR HAND!

(DANIELLE)

(WITH NAUTICA & LA CIENEGA)

YOU CAN CALL US ARROGANT
BUT WE WORK FOR WHAT WE HAVE
CALL US WHAT (EVER) IS (CLEVER) FOR(EVER)
PLEASE, BUT DON'T (YOU EVER CALL US)
"RAH RAH SIS BOOM BAH."

DANIELLE

But what about you, Miss Bridget? Were you a "cheerleader" too?

BRIDGET

Oh my lands no, they never let me on the squad.

DANIELLE

Hm. "They" never let you on the squad.

LA CIENEGA

But you know some moves?

TWIG

Yeah, c'mon, girl, show us what you got.

BRIDGET

Oooohh, me? I got not very much -

TWIG

But you got the sweetest booty in this whole parking lot!

DANIELLE

Tell ya what. Come work with the crew and we'll show you how to really move.

BRIDGET

You'd do that?

DANIELLE

With pleasure. I'd rather work with a girl I can build up than one I gotta knock off her perch. So Miss Bridget, you're in the finest dance crew between these two here oceans!

YOU CAN CALL YOUR THERAPIST,

NAUTICA & LA CIENEGA

AIN'T RIGHT!

(With NAUTICA & LA CIENEGA)

DIDN'T MEAN TO SCARE YOU, HONEY!

NAUTICA & LA CIENEGA

"RAH RAH, SIS BOOM -"

DANIELLE, LA CIENEGA & NAUTICA

HA!

SCENE SEVEN PHONE CALLS

#8a - Phone Calls / To The Pagoda

A series of voice messages for Campbell. On Eva:

EVA

HEY CAMPBELL! GUESS WHO?

HOPE YOU'RE DOING GREAT – ME TOO!
GUESS WHAT? I GOT YOUR UNIFORM
WITH YOUR NAME ON IT
IT'S A PERFECT FIT
ONCE I TOOK IT IN
JUST A LITTLE BIT
NOW I'M LIKE A YOUNGER YOU!

On Skylar and Kylar:

SKYLAR

HEY SNOT! WHAT'S HOT?

I WISH YOU WERE CAPTAIN — NOT!

GOT YOUR TEXTS AND ALL —

SKYLAR & KYLAR

AND WE MEANT TO CALL

KYLAR

CHANNEL TWO WAS HERE TO FILM US CHEER!

SKYLAR & KYLAR

KAY LOVE YOU!

SKYLAR

DON'T GET SHOT!

On Steven, who sings cloyingly:

STEVEN

HAPPY KITTIES – (SLEEPY PUPPIES) – BABY DUCKIES –

OPERATOR VOICE

If you are satisfied with your message, press three.

STEVEN

Argh!

SCENE EIGHT BURGER PAGODA

At a fast-food burger joint with an incongruous Asian theme, Bridget enters with Campbell.

CAMPBELL

Everyone at Truman's doing just fine without me, and everyone at Jackson hates my guts. Especially Danielle.

BRIDGET

All you did was give her a negative first impression. But you still want to be on the dance crew?

CAMPBELL

So bad.

BRIDGET

Then talk to her again.

CAMPBELL

Maybe I'll talk to her during study hall. In 2047.

BRIDGET

No - talk to her now.

She points at the server behind the counter. It's Danielle. Shocked, Campbell hides behind Bridget.

CAMPBELL

Omigod, I didn't know she worked here.

BRIDGET

Why do you think I brought you?

Campbell starts toward Danielle, then turns back.

CAMPBELL

I can't. I don't have any self-esteem left.

BRIDGET

(sincerely)

Then take some of mine.

(beat)

Psyche! I don't have any either. C'mon.

Bridget leads Campbell to the counter. Two richlooking girls enter and stand in line behind them.

Welcome to Burger Pagoda.

CAMPBELL

Hi Danielle, listen — I got off to a bad start the other day.

DANIELLE

Here we go.

CAMPBELL

But I know you're looking for someone to be on your squad -

DANIELLE

Crew.

CAMPBELL

Crew, right, and I could definitely work hard and measure up and all that.

DANIELLE

So you say. I'll think about it. Now did you want to order?

CAMPBELL

I'm — not hungry.

RICH GIRL 2

What's it to you?

CAMPBELL

Listen here, little girl. You call my friend by her NAME -

She turns to Danielle, who points to her name badge. Campbell turns back to the girls.

__ "Julio."

(turning back to Danielle)

"Julio?"

You read it right. I found this nametag in the break room. He's my secret identity now.

CAMPBELL

(turning back to the girls)

All right, then you call her "Julio." Got it?

RICH GIRL 1

Oooh, I'm scared.

CAMPBELL

Yeah, you should be. I mean, I may look nice now, but just peeve my cheese one more time and press "play."

RICH GIRL 2

And then what?

CAMPBELL

And then you find out — what it is I do when I get, y'know, aggravated. Which doesn't happen a lot. If ever. But you're gonna be all like, "I can't believe that girl went all postal like that." So — in summation — watch your mouth around Julio. Got it?

RICH GIRL 1

Let's get some pizza.

The girls turn and exit. Danielle is laughing.

DANIELLE

That was the whitest beatdown I ever heard.

CAMPBELL

See you in class.

She turns to go.

DANIELLE

Hey. – Thanks.

CAMPBELL

I just hate it when people do that.

DANIELLE

Welcome to my world. Some people see me as the "burger girl" but when I put on this outfit I see myself representing at college some day. But you had my back and I appreciate it.

CAMPBELL

Oh. Cool. I mean, sure. Yeah.

You said you wanted to be on the crew. Why?

CAMPBELL

Without cheerleading, I feel like I'm not anybody.

DANIELLE

You're still standing.

CAMPBELL

Barely. I felt so lost until I saw what you do. I could be valuable. I'll do anything to prove myself.

Beat.

DANIELLE

Our crew's doin' a special number at the party after the Homecoming game.

CAMPBELL

Yeah?

DANIELLE

So I was thinking, what we need is a THEME. And I took a spin through the school basement and Miss Bridget, what do I see in the dusty-ass back of the room?

BRIDGET

What DO you see in the dusty-ass back of the room?

DANIELLE

A mascot outfit, a Leprechaun suit, from the old days when Jackson was an Irish neighborhood. And I think, "There's our theme, queen." And I snapped it up like it was Versace at a yard sale. But we need someone to wear it, if you get my drift.

BRIDGET

Please tell me that isn't my cue to volunteer.

DANIELLE

Not you, Miss Bridget. You're in the crew. What we need is someone: peppy!

She gazes smilingly at Campbell. A moment.

CAMPBELL

A leprechaun suit? I'm on board. I'm tougher than I look.

Just wait.

CAMERON

THAT'S RIGHT.

ENSEMBLE 1&2

WELCOME TO JACKSON - MOVE.

Campbell enters awkwardly in the Leprechaun suit and joins the dance.

TWIG

WELCOME TO JACKSON!

NAUTICA

NO SHE DIDN'T!

GUYS

MOVE!

BRIDGET

SHE COULD GET IT!

GUYS

MOVE!

Impressed hubbub. Overlap:

GIRLS

GO! GO! GO! GO! GO! GO! GO!

GO! GO! GO! GO! GO! GO! GO!

CAMERON (With Some MEN)

THAT'S MY GIRL IN THE MIDDLE OF THE CROWD! EV'RYBODY HERE BETTER GET LOUD THAT'S MY GIRL IN THE MIDDLE OF THE CROWD!

ALL GIRLS

MOVE! GO LUCKY! GO, GO, GO LUCKY!

Cheers. Fierce Leprechaun dance break.

ALL

MOVE! MOVE! MOVE!

DANIELLE

(watching Campbell)

LOOK AT THIS LITTLE RICH WHITE GIRL TURNIN' IT OUT,
WOW, I CAN'T BE MAD AT THAT.
LOOK AT HER GO!
LOOK AT THIS LITTLE RICH WHITE GIRL MOVIN' THE CROWD,
WOW, SHE'S NOT HALF-BAD AT THAT,
LOOK AT HER GO!

GIRLS

I KNOW YOU CAME HERE JUST TO SEE ME TONIGHT, SO WHAT ARE YOU WAITING FOR?

GUYS

#9a - Campbell's In

After the number, the girls assemble.

NAUTICA

(to Bridget)

Honey, you were SICKENING out there. That was toxic!

BRIDGET

(to La Cienega)

Can you translate?

LA CIENEGA

You did very good and we're proud of you.

BRIDGET

Werque!

Danielle approaches Campbell, who's gasping for breath in her Leprechaun suit.

DANIELLE

Yo, Lucky McClover.

CAMPBELL

Yeah?

DANIELLE

You missed a move.

CAMPBELL

I know, I'm so sorry — I tripped over these shoes. But—how'd I do otherwise?

DANIELLE

I'll admit: putting you in that smelly-ass suit wasn't the nicest thing I ever did. But you showed up, and then, dammit, you stole the whole show. Nobody was even looking at the rest of us.

CAMPBELL

Oh, God, I'm sorry.

DANIELLE

Put away the "sorry." Count me impressed.

CAMPBELL

Really?

DANIELLE

I don't put my faith in a lot of people but I'm putting my faith in you.

CAMPBELL

Wait - so I'm in? The "crew?"

The other girls gather.

DANIELLE

This crew is a family. So welcome to our family.

As they congratulate Campbell -

CAMPBELL

Omigod, thank you! You won't regret it!

They hug as the crew gathers around, congratulating her. We transition to Campbell's bedroom ...

(CAMPBELL)

(giddily to herself)

LOOK AT THIS LITTLE HOT WHITE GIRL TURNING IT OUT! WOW!
THIS LEPRECHAUN'S ON THE CREW!
LOOK AT HER GO!

I WAS SO GOOD AND EVERYONE WATCHED ME DANCE! WOW!

NOW WATCH ME BRUSH MY TEETH

IT'S THE CAMPBELL SHOW!

GO! GO! GO!

SCENE TEN CAMPBELL'S BEDROOM

A series of video chats. Skylar appears, her mascara running.

SKYLAR

Campbell!

CAMPBELL

Hey Skylar! How's things at the old homestead?

Skylar sobs.

Skylar, what's wrong?

SKYLAR

I failed Home Ec!

CAMPBELL

How can anybody fail Home Ec?

SKYLAR

They found an error on my report card from last year — I thought I pulled a "D" but instead I got an "F"!

CAMPBELL

Skylar, it's only Home Ec! Just try something - easier, next semester -

SKYLAR

I don't care about my GRADES. The rules say the captain has to maintain a 1.2 GPA. I went to a lot of EFFORT to do the bare minimum. And now I have to resign as Captain!

CAMPBELL

What?

Another window "bloops" in. It's Kylar, who looks very drowsy.

KYLAR

Campbell.

CAMPBELL

Kylar?

SKYLAR

So the new Captain is Kylar!

CAMPBELL

Kylar?

KYLAR

I have mono.

CAMPBELL

What did you say?

SKYLAR

I said, the new Captain is Kylar!

KYLAR

I have mono.

CAMPBELL

You're sick?

SKYLAR

No, I failed Home Ec!

KYLAR

I have to leave the squad 'til I'm better. I was supposed to be Captain and I can't do it now.

#10 - Something Isn't Right Here

CAMPBELL

I'm so confused!

SKYLAR

Kylar, you're not Captain any more?

KYLAR

I'm not Captain any more.

CAMPBELL

Oh my God!

KYLAR & SKYLAR

So Eva's the Captain now.

CAMPBELL

Eva?

KYLAR & SKYLAR

A Sophomore.

CAMPBELL

That Sophomore is captain of the squad?

KYLAR & SKYLAR

Yes. I have to go.

KYLAR

I'm so sleepy.

SKYLAR

I'm so sad.

CAMPBELL

I'm so — Oh my God.

SKYLAR

Good night.

Kylar sneezes.

SKYLAR

I am so upset I'm actually going to go eat something.

Their windows vanish, leaving Campbell alone.

CAMPBELL

(sings)

I PUT HER ON THE TEAM
SHE WAS GREEN AS SHE COULD BE.
I DID IT TO BE NICE.
NO ONE WANTED HER BUT ME.

ALL MY DREAMS WERE COMING TRUE
I WAS CAPTAIN, IT WAS COOL
THEN I'M SUDDENLY REDIST — REDI—
SENT TO ANOTHER SCHOOL!

SO SKYLAR'S NEXT IN LINE
BUT SOMEHOW SKYLAR FLUNKS
SO KYLAR SHOULD BE CAPTAIN
BUT KYLAR'S BLOWING CHUNKS!

IS THIS ALL COINCIDENCE?

JUST UNRELATED INCIDENTS

THAT HAPPENED TO OCCUR?

MIRACULOUSLY MAKING WAY FOR HER?

SOMETHING ISN'T RIGHT HERE –
I DON'T KNOW WHAT IT IS.
NONE OF THIS SHOULD BE HAPPENING,

(CAMPBELL)

BUT IT IS—OH, BUT IT IS!

IT'S LIKE HEARING A TICKING SOUND

COMING FROM UNMARKED PACKAGES!

Doorbell. We transit to Eva's house.

EVA

Hang on, I'll be right there.

Eva enters. Her hair color matches Campbell's.

Campbell!

CAMPBELL

Nice. Hair.

EVA

Thanks!

CAMPBELL

Eva, I love what you've done with your room.

EVA

You know you've always been my inspiration.

CAMPBELL

Clearly.

SOMETHING ISN'T RIGHT HERE,
I GOT A SPIDEY SENSE.
TOO MUCH HAS BEEN GOING DOWN
TO CHALK IT UP
TO COINCIDENCE—

EVA

What coincidence?

CAMPBELL

That you, a Sophomore, suddenly became captain of the squad.

EVA

Campbell, that really hurts my feelings. You think I did all this on purpose? I'd never take anything away from you.

Steven enters, holding his shirt.

STEVEN

You're right! Club soda CAN get out a Yoo-Hoo stain.

CAMPBELL

Steven?

STEVEN

Baby! What are you doing?

CAMPBELL

SOMETHING ISN'T RIGHT HERE.

STEVEN

Baby, it's no big.

CAMPBELL

SOMETHING ISN'T RIGHT HERE!

STEVEN

Eva's helping me with Trig!

CAMPBELL

Eva's helping you with Trig?! That's news to me.

EVA

Oh, Campbell, it's totally nothing. I just offered to help.

CAMPBELL

YOUR ALIBI'S PATHETIC

I'M HERE TO CALL YOUR BLUFF!

THERE'S NO WAY YOU'VE STUDIED TRIG YET!

THERE'S NO WAY HE CARES ENOUGH!

MADE THE TEAM, THEN YOU MADE CAPTAIN -

NOW YOU'RE ALL UP IN HIS STUFF!

STEVEN

Baby, you're gonna make yourself crazy thinking like that.

EVA

Listen, Campbell, if I could trade back with you I would.

STEVEN

(consolingly, to Campbell)

Oh, c'mere. I know what you need.

Campbell shakes her head. Steven smiles.

STEVEN

HAPPY KITTIES.

A moment.

CAMPBELL

SLEEPY PUPPIES.

STEVEN

BABY DUCKIES.

EVA & CAMPBELL

SPARKLE PONIES.

Campbell's head snaps front.

CAMPBELL

What. Did you just say.

EVA

Oh, Steven told me that's how you guys make each other feel better, that's all. Campbell — Campbell, I'm your *friend*.

CAMPBELL

I'm sorry -

(to Steven)

I don't think we should see each other for awhile. Like-forever-while.

STEVEN

Baby, what -

She exits Eva's house and rushes over to Skylar and a sickly Kylar.

CAMPBELL

SHE DID IT! SHE DID IT!
SHE CAME UP WITH A PLAN!
TO TAKE ALL THAT SHE TOOK,
MY TEAM, MY SCHOOL MY MAN!
NEXT SHE'LL WIN THE LOTTO!
OR CRAP A FOUR-LEAF CLOVER!
CAN IT JUST BE ME
WHO SEES HOW SHE SCREWED US OVER?

KYLAR

SO IT'S HER FAULT I GOT MONO?

AND FOR SKYLAR'S FAILING TOO?

AND SHE SOMEHOW GOT YOU TRANSFERRED

AND THIS WHOLE THING'S ABOUT YOU?

SKYLAR

YEAH OUR TEAM'S WITHOUT A CAPTAIN AND OUR CHANCES ARE-N'T GREAT BUT DON'T BLAME IT ON YOUR MINI-ME SHE STEPPED UP TO THE PLATE.

KYLAR

SHE'S BARELY OUT OF DIAPERS!

SKYLAR

AND YET YOU'RE SURE IT'S TRUE

SKYLAR & KYLAR

SHE'S GETTING WITH YOUR MAN WHO WE ALL KNOW WORSHIPS YOU?

SKYLAR

YEAH, I SEE WHAT'S WRONG
UNLESS YOU HAVE MORE TO TELL US!
YOU'RE PARANOID!

KYLAR

YOU'RE CRAZY!

SKYLAR & KYLAR

OR MAYBE YOU'RE JUST JEALOUS!

Skylar and Kylar exit.

CAMPBELL

Jealous?! What - me? That's ridiculous!

They exit. Campbell is alone:

Maybe they're right. Maybe I am jealous. I don't know anymore.

(turning to Bridget, who is entering)

But I still have this feeling.

BRIDGET

Okay, then let's examine the evidence.

CAMPBELL

Her bedroom looks just like mine.

BRIDGET

She copied your crib, check.

CAMPBELL

Her hair looks just like mine.

BRIDGET

She stole your weave, check.

CAMPBELL

AND she's been macking on Steven this entire time.

BRIDGET

Shut the front door and slap my ass with the screen!

CAMPBELL

All that, AND she's captain of the squad.

BRIDGET

That, and Eva's mom's on the school board. But maybe that's not important.

CAMPBELL

Her mom - is what?

BRIDGET

On the school board. The school board that decided on the redistricting. You didn't know that?

Dramatic sting.

CAMPBELL

What?

BRIDGET

Look, bad things happen to people all the time. You just get used to it.

Campbell is alone.

#11 - Bring It On

CAMPBELL

(softly)

No.

(sings)

GONE

MY ONE CHANCE TO SHINE, THE FRIENDS I CALLED MINE,

THE GIRL THE WORLD WILL NEVER SEE.

(CAMPBELL)

MORE THAN REPLACED, IT'S LIKE SHE'S ERASED THE BEST OF ME.

I HAVE NO CHOICE
I'VE GOT TO TAKE BACK WHAT SHE STOLE.
GET BACK MY ONE MOMENT!

MADE A VOW I WAS GONNA BE
A CHEERLEADER LIKE THE BUCCANEERS IN FRONT OF ME!
NOW IF ONLY I COULD FIND A WAY
TO GET BACK INTO THE NATIONALS AND MAKE HER PAY!

The ensemble begins to appear, as if conjured:

NAUTICA!

LA CIENEGA!

DANIELLE!

ENSEMBLE

JACKSON, JACKSON! GO JACKSON, GO JACKSON! GO, GO, GO JACKSON GO!

DANIELLE, NAUTICA, LA CIENEGA, TWIG, CAMERON

OOOOOOOOH!

LET EVERYBODY KNOW

CAMPBELL'S BACK -

CAMPBELL

THIS IS MY TOWN!

OOOOOOOOH!

ALL

AND EVA'S GOING DOWN!

"Dream Eva" enters as syrupy voices overlap:

VOICES

Eva is like the coolest, best, sweetest cheer captain ... I'm in love with Eva Omigod!

ENSEMBLE

BRING IT ON! GO!

BRING IT ON! GO CAMPBELL!

BRING IT ON! GO CAMPBELL GO!

Fierce dance section.

CAMPBELL

I'LL TAKE FIRST PLACE

AND THROW IT IN YOUR FACE!

ENSEMBLE

RRRRRAH!

CAMPBELL

THINK YOU CAN BEAT ME? GO AHEAD, C'MON!
AND ONCE I HAVE MY SQUAD
YOU'LL FEEL THE WRATH OF GOD —

ENSEMBLE

SO LET THE DOUBTERS, AND THE HATERS AND MY TEARS BE GONE!

CAMPBELL

I'M GONNA BRING IT ON!

ENSEMBLE

MY YEAR! MY TIME!

CAMPBELL

I'M GONNA BRING IT ON!

ENSEMBLE

MY DESTINY!

BRING IT ON -

CAMPBELL

GONNA BRING IT ON!

End of Act One.

ACT TWO

#12 - Entr'acte

Campbell stands center-stage in a reverie as Dream Eva skips in circles around her. Scenery moves in around Campbell and we're in the...

SCENE ONE JACKSON LUNCH ROOM

Campbell turns and addresses a passing Danielle. **CAMPBELL** Danielle? DANIELLE Hm. **CAMPBELL** Listen, I had an idea. DANIELLE Shoot. **CAMPBELL** So - what we're doing is really athletic and dance-oriented and made, you know, to get audiences all fired up -DANIELLE Uh huh. **CAMPBELL** - so I was thinking, you know, we could make a squad. A moment. DANIELLE

Define "squad" -

CAMPBELL

Instead of a "crew," we'd be a "squad."

(very quietly)

A cheer leading squad.

Danielle laughs ruefully.

You know what this reminds me of? Those movies, you know what I'm saying, where the white dude or white lady makes a trip to the scary "inner city" and, you know, fixes dem colored folks right up!

CAMPBELL

No no no, it's not that at all, it's that we're — you're way sick, I mean "sick" in the positive way, and with just a few wee changes, you could get a lot of exposure and credit —

DANIELLE

-and "rah rah" at the football games -

CAMPBELL

-and be on ESPN -

DANIELLE

- and have everyone thinking we're a bunch of stuck-up bitches -

NAUTICA

But we are stuck-up bitches.

BRIDGET

We so are.

DANIELLE

Not. Interested. Now may I —

Campbell jumps in, desperate:

CAMPBELL

And whoever wins at Nationals this year gets a 12-part reality series on MTV. They just announced it.

DANIELLE

Ugh.

CAMPBELL

And that could lead to, y'know, more success down the road.

DANIELLE

I would hardly define "success" as humiliating my ass on a reality show.

NAUTICA

Oh, I would.

LA CIENEGA

Oh, me too completely.

NAUTICA

Completely.

CAMPBELL

And each member of the winning squad gets a scholarship to the college of their choice.

Danielle hesitates, considering.

DANIELLE

LA CIENEGA

So it HAS to be true!

CAMERON & (GUY BACKUP)

PICTURE ME, WEARIN' THE TWO-THREE

LIKE JORDAN WORE WHEN HE DUNKED FROM THE FREE

THROW LINE, A LEGEND IN HIS OWN TIME,

BUT I'M JUST A LEGEND IN MY OWN MIND.

(GIMME THE BALL), AND FALL BACK, I GOT THIS!

Attention Buccaneers! Eyes. Eyes on me, everybody. There we go.

(pointing to one audience member)

Chelsea, take your Ritalin. Eyes. Thank you.

(to the group)

All right, we need to keep focused. One fall can blow a whole year of work. Don't cross or even touch the lines around the performing area. Never fix your hair or outfit during a routine. We all have to work together and smile while we suffer. 'Cause why are we doing this? Is it for the glory? No. For the trophy? No. We're doing this...

(Satanic vocal distortion)

TO DESTROY CAMPBELL DAVIS AND SEND HER SOUL TO ROT IN HELL.

ENSEMBLE

CAMPBELL - BAK-TUK!

CAMPBELL - BASKE-TUS!

CAMPBELL! CAMPBELL! CAMPBELL!

Lights on Campbell, shaken, at practice. Randall stands next to her.

RANDALL

Hey - are you in there?

CAMPBELL

Sorry. I'm just — daydreaming. How's the music coming?

RANDALL

I added eight counts after "Get Ready For Jackson" so you can do your shopping cart throw.

CAMPBELL

"Basket toss," but close.

DANIELLE

Hey, check this out, we worked up a little section for the routine.

(DANIELLE)

(calling off)

Miss Lady, get your perky ass over here. Hit it, Randall.

#13b - Miss Lady

Randall starts the music. La Cienega makes a grand entrance in a cheer leading outfit and the three girls demonstrate a saucy dance sequence. The other students get into it. It builds ...

CAMPBELL

Okay, stop! STOP! - I love it!

NAUTICA

Ooh, there's a "but" coming.

CAMPBELL

The judges'll deduct hella points if we do that. I'm sorry.

LA CIENEGA

I am so about to start pouting. Oh wait, it started.

DANIELLE

C'mon, now - sometimes you gotta break the rules if you want to fly.

CAMPBELL

Sure, but don't we want to win?

DANIELLE

And the girl has a point. Okay, we can save that section for the after-party.

LA CIENEGA

(completely recovered)

Okay!

DANIELLE

So what's next in the master plan?

CAMPBELL

What's next, Bridget?

BRIDGET

(consulting a list)

Cheer face.

CAMPBELL

Right. So we're doing back-breaking feats of athleticism, sure, but we cannot forget our "cheer face."

MILLS

Our hummina what?

CAMPBELL

This is very, very important. Bridget, can you show them "cheer face" please?

Bridget offers a series of rather horrifying "cheer faces."

(continuing, over)

As we see, Bridget is demonstrating a variety of emotions that should conflict but live in an ideal harmony. Here we see, "I'm an accomplished athlete who is dedicated to my craft, but I just did something a little naughty and I shocked myself a whole lot." Thank you, Bridget.

Bridget relaxes.

So "cheer faces" all around, please. On three -

CAMERON

Hold it. No - really? I mean, really?

CAMPBELL

Right, thank you, Cameron, it's different for the guys. Men, keep those feelings bottled inside, covered by shades of "steely determination." So hit your "cheer faces," everybody!

The group makes a sorry assortment of "cheer faces" as Randall re-enters. He stops, shocked.

RANDALL

I leave the room for five seconds -

CAMPBELL

Quit undermining my authority.

RANDALL

But you're so cute when I undermine you.

CAMPBELL

Ignore that man — who needs to shut the barn door, by the way, because his horse is busting out.

Embarrassed, Randall zips his fly.

So focus. We have to be perfect and play by their rules. In five weeks we're gonna be waiting in that holding area at Regionals. And we want to be prepped when that voice comes over the loudspeaker —

SCENE THREE REGIONALS QUALIFYING ROUND

#14 – Better

ANNOUNCER

Next on the mat at Regionals, put your hands together for Jackson High School!

The Truman squad is watching.

EVA

WOW!

THEY'RE REALLY NOT THAT BAD -

SKYLAR

BUT WE'RE BETTER.

KYLAR

THEY NAILED THAT BASKET TOSS -

SKYLAR

BUT WE'RE BETTER.

EVA & KYLAR

IT'S A MIRACLE THEY'RE HERE -

SKYLAR

STILL BETTER.

STEVEN

AND THAT FLIP WAS CRAZY SAUCE!

SKYLAR

BUT WE'RE-

KYLAR

LOOK! THEY'RE BLOWING UP ON TWITTER!

SKYLAR

THEY'RE ONLY GLUE AND GLITTER.

EVA

NOW SKYLAR, DON'T BE BITTER -

SKYLAR

BUT WE'RE BETTER!

ANNOUNCER

And our first runner-up, accumulating enough points to qualify for Nationals: the Jackson Irish!

SKYLAR

They're going to Nationals — What about US —?

ANNOUNCER

And today's winner is - Truman High School!

SKYLAR

SEE?

WE'RE BETTER BETTER BETTER BETTER
BETTER BETTER BETTER!
BETTER BETTER BETTER BETTER—

IT'S NICE THAT THEY COMPETE.
THEIR ENTHUSIASM'S SWEET.
I LOVE HOW THEY'RE SO 'STREET'
BUT DO I NEED TO REPEAT:

WE'RE HOTTER!
WE'RE RICHER!
OUR UNIFORM'S CUTER!
AND WE'RE SO MUCH BETTER THAN THEM!
OH, YE —

Campbell has entered and is standing by Skylar. Song ends abruptly.

SKYLAR

Oh hi Campbell.

CAMPBELL

Congratulations on your win.

Eva approaches.

EVA

Omigod you guys did so good!

CAMPBELL

Oh hello, Eva. I hear you're doing a nifty job as Captain.

EVA

We're all freaking over how well you guys did. I mean, we're scared, right?

#14a - Douchenozzle in Hell

(EVA)

(Satanic vocal distortion)

SCARED YOU'RE GOING TO LOOK LIKE A DOUCHENOZZLE IN FRONT OF THE ENTIRE WORLD.

SKYLAR, KYLAR, STEVEN

MAJOR DOUCHE!

MAJOR DOUCHE!

MAJOR DOUCHE!

Lights blink.

EVA

(continuing blithely)

Scared you're gonna beat us! - Hey, you okay, hon?

CAMPBELL

Fine -

SKYLAR

I gotta give Eva props, she knocked us right into shape.

KYLAR

Right into shape.

SKYLAR

I'm serious.

KYLAR

(re: Skylar)

She's serious.

EVA

Oh, you guys!

CAMPBELL

Steven, I expected you'd be happy under her attention.

STEVEN

Hey, Campbell.

CAMPBELL

Mmm-hmm.

EVA

Let's all hit the juice bar.

CAMPBELL

No thanks.

EVA

Well don't work TOO hard, now! I'm just teasing.

Truman squad exits, Jackson squad enters.

DANIELLE

Well, well! Who knew I'd be so happy to come in second?

CAMPBELL

We're going to Nationals!

DANIELLE

I never thought these words would come out of my mouth, but here we go: I'm actually proud to be a cheerleader.

CAMPBELL

See -?

DANIELLE

If the me a couple months ago could see the me now — I won't even start. But I'll admit: I had *stupid* fun putting this together with you.

CAMPBELL

Me too.

DANIELLE

We squeaked by today, but Nationals is gonna get our Jackson A-game! See you at practice!

NAUTICA

Honey, you ain't no Cream of Mushroom to us no more.

LA CIENEGA

Girl, you're CHICKEN AND STARS!

#14b - It's On, Eva

The girls walk off, leaving Campbell alone. She is still, poised, determined:

CAMPBELL

It's on, Eva. Oh, it's on.

SCENE FOUR HALLWAY

Bridget stands at a sign-up board. Twig approaches.

TWIG

Hey, sex kitten.

Bridget looks around her.

TWIG

I'm talking to you.

BRIDGET

Oh! I thought you said, "Hey, sex kitten."

TWIG

I did.

BRIDGET

Oh.

TWIG

So. What you doin' on Friday Night, baby?

BRIDGET

Me? Well, there's a "Doctor Who" marathon on, and -

TWIG

(moving in on her)

Uh huh.

BRIDGET

— and I was, um, planning to fire up some kettle corn and just, like, party, you know?

(A moment.)

Look, can I be honest?

TWIG

Shoot.

BRIDGET

I took a vow to protect my flower.

TWIG

I just wanna hang with you, is all. You know what I'm saying?

BRIDGET

I'm a bit new at this. Boys.

TWIG

We're fifty percent of the population. I think it's time you got some instruction.

BRIDGET

There's an app for that.

A moment.

TWIG

Whatever you say - sex kitten. Oooh!

He waits a moment, and strolls off. Nautica and La Cienega approach Bridget.

NAUTICA

Now why you throwing shade at him?

LA CIENEGA

Twig is fine.

BRIDGET

I didn't mean to provide shade. But I think he wants to French me!

NAUTICA

So what — you're gonna Taze him for it?

BRIDGET

No one thinks I'm sexy. Or even reasonably attractive.

LA CIENEGA

They do now, sexy.

BRIDGET

I have a mirror, you know?

NAUTICA

Now you wash that mouth out. That low self-esteem B.S. does not fly with us.

BRIDGET

I wasn't born the way other people are. You don't know what it's like not to fit in.

A moment. La Cienega moves Nautica aside.

LA CIENEGA

I mean, really?

BRIDGET

I'm confused, is all. Which makes me neurotic and weird, which could lead to my own very special episode of "Hoarders" by the time I'm 21.

NAUTICA

Naw, what you're feeling is power, honey. And power can be a scary thing. But it's all in the way you use it. So use it. Don't lose it.

#15 - It Ain't No Thing

(sings)

THERE'S A SAYING THAT I LEARNED
PASSED DOWN THROUGH CENTURIES
WHICH TRANSLATED FROM THE FRENCH MEANS
'SISTA, PLEASE!'
GIRL, YOU'RE SPECIAL —

I'M DADDY'S LITTLE BIG SURPRISE!

LA CIENEGA & NAUTICA

IT AIN'T NO THING, YEAH!

LOVE WHO YOU ARE

AND THE WORLD WILL ADORE YOU –

LA CIENEGA

AND THE COUPLE THAT DON'T
AT LEAST THEY CAN'T IGNORE YOU!
NOW BOYS ALL WANT TO BUY ME BLING—
IT AIN'T NO THING, YEAH!
IT AIN'T NO THING! YEAH—

NAUTICA & HALLWAY MEN

NA NA NA! HEY, HEY! NA NA NA! HEY, HEY! NA NA NA! HEY, HEY! NA NA NA! HEY, HEY!

LA CIENEGA

DON'T WALK AWAY AND LEAVE CASES UNOPENED WHEN YOU'RE PLAYING 'DEAL OR NO DEAL' –

NAUTICA

NO DEAL!

AND DON'T YOU JUST TAKE LITTLE PIECES OF LIFE,

LA CIENEGA & NAUTICA

TREAT YOURSELF TO THE SEVEN COURSE MEAL!

BRIDGET

OH, OH! I'VE BEEN HATIN' ON MYSELF UNNECESSARILY!

LA CIENEGA & NAUTICA

NO NO NO!

BRIDGET

I'M HERE TO STATE I'M FEELING GREAT CELEBRATIN' ME!

LA CIENEGA & NAUTICA

YEAH, YEAH!

BRIDGET (NAUTICA & LA CIENEGA)

I'VE GOT A BIG BUTT (WORK!)—WELL, SO WHAT? (WORK!)
IT'S GOOD AS ANY OTHER (WOO, WOO, WOO!)
AND I THINK OF YOU AS SISTERS FROM ANOTHER MOTHER!
YEAH I GOT SOME JUNK UP IN MY TRUNK! (BACK IT ON UP!)
IT AIN'T NO THING, YEAH!

LA CIENEGA & NAUTICA

IT AIN'T NO THING! NO IT AIN'T, NO

NAUTICA & LA CIENEGA

WHOO!

BRIDGET

IT AIN'T NO THANG!

LA CIENEGA & NAUTICA

NA NA NA NA, HEY HEY –

BRIDGET

I MEAN IT AIN'T NO THING! OH NO, IT AIN'T NO THING!

LA CIENEGA & NAUTICA

NA NA NA! HEY HEY! NA NA NA! HEY HEY! NO IT AIN'T!

BRIDGET, NAUTICA, LA CIENEGA

NO IT AIN'T!

BRIDGET

NO, IT AIN'T NO THING!

NAUTICA

Now you go find that boy and tell him you are free Friday night.

BRIDGET

Gosh darnit, I will!

LA CIENEGA

Language, honey child, please.

BRIDGET

(riffing mightily)

IT AIN'T NO THING!

Bridget moves confidently off after Twig.

SCENE FIVE HALLWAY AT JACKSON

#15a - Bridget + Twig

Later that day, Campbell approaches Randall at his locker.

ENSEMBLE

NA NA NA! HEY HEY! NA NA NA! HEY HEY!
NA NA NA! HEY HEY! NA NA NA! HEY HEY!
NA NA NA! HEY HEY! NO IT AIN'T, NO IT AIN'T!

CAMPBELL

Hey.

RANDALL

But — this can't be possible!

CAMPBELL

What.

RANDALL

Is this a mirage I see before me? The new queen bee of Jackson High, deigning to address a mere peasant?

CAMPBELL

Oh buh-ruther.

RANDALL

Congrats on your triumph at regionals.

CAMPBELL

It was your music that did it, you know.

RANDALL

All you had to do was press "play." So listen — are you going to that Prom thing by any chance?

CAMPBELL

Nobody asked me.

RANDALL

Cause I have zero interest in it -

CAMPBELL

Oh.

RANDALL

I mean, who looks back on those pictures and thinks, "I looked great then"?

(a moment)

Oh wait. You thought I was gonna ask you.

CAMPBELL

You brought it up, so

RANDALL

What *I* was thinking was that you and me could have a picnic on the cliff at Shore Acres.

CAMPBELL

Really? I've never been up there.

RANDALL

Then think about it.

CAMPBELL

I did.

(a moment)

When should I show up?

RANDALL

Seven.

CAMPBELL

'Kay.

RANDALL

No prom dress, no corsage, or you won't get past the bouncer.

Danielle, Nautica, Cameron, and La Cienega approach Campbell. Bridget trails behind.

DANIELLE

(to the others)

Hey, I got a question.

LA CIENEGA

What you need, girl?

DANIELLE

Am I wearing a sign on my chest that says "Pinocchio"?

LA CIENEGA

I don't see no sign.

NAUTICA

No sign, mmm hmm.

Danielle turns to Campbell.

DANIELLE

Do you see a sign on my chest that says "Pinocchio"?

CAMPBELL

Uh - no -

DANIELLE

Funny. 'Cause somebody's been treating me like a PUPPET.

CAMPBELL

Look -

LA CIENEGA

We ain't getting no reality show!

DANIELLE

And no scholarships. All we get if we take Nationals is a damn hoodie and a tacky-ass trophy!

CAMERON

And don't get me started on that Jordan lie!

CAMPBELL

How did – how do you know?

DANIELLE

I got Google, bitch.

A moment.

CAMPBELL

Look — it was — this girl Eva at the other school, she manipulated the system to get me out and become captain. And I wanted to get — revenge.

DANIELLE

Hold on. Back up.

CAMPBELL

What.

DANIELLE

You're telling me — some girl came in on turf that wasn't hers, and lied and cheated and manipulated until she was running the whole show?

CAMPBELL

Exactly.

DANIELLE

I wasn't talking about her. I was talking about YOU.

A moment. Campbell averts her eyes.

CAMPBELL

Oh.

DANIELLE

You look at me. I work night after night pushing burgers and then study 'til dawn to get my ass to college and fly the hell out of my circumstances. You KNEW that. And you hit me right where I'm vulnerable so you could get yourself ahead.

CAMPBELL

I'm so sorry.

DANIELLE

And you think that's enough. We're done. Funny about you. You're all about the rules when it means you can win, but you forgot: friendship has rules, too. I thought you respected that. Stupid me for being so damn naive.

She exits with La Cienega and Nautica. Bridget remains.

CAMPBELL

Oh God, what am I gonna do?

BRIDGET

(hesitantly)

Campbell, I'm your friend. I'll always try to be. But I don't know who you're becoming.

CAMPBELL

Bridget -

BRIDGET

I mean, you lied to me too.

Bridget exits. Campbell stands alone, stunned.

#16 - What Was I Thinking

CAMPBELL

I'M NOT FREAKING OUT,
I'M REALLY OKAY —
I'M NOT FREAKING OUT,
I'M REALLY OKAY —

(CAMPBELL)

WHAT WAS I THINKING? WHAT WAS I THINKING? WHAT WAS I THINKING?

ENSEMBLE

OH, OH -

ENSEMBLE (And CAMPBELL)

WHAT WAS I THINKING? (WHAT WAS I THINKING?)
WHAT WAS I THINKING? (WHAT WAS I THINKING?)
WHAT WAS I THINKING, THINKING, THINKING—
OH, OH, OH, OH —

SCENE SIX

Randall waits. Campbell enters, in despair.

RANDALL

Happy Prom.

CAMPBELL

I didn't think you were gonna show.

(A moment.)

Did you hear what happened?

RANDALL

I got a few Tweets. And texts. Facebook updates. Someone even told me in person. So how ya doin'?

CAMPBELL

Do you hate me?

RANDALL

Do I look like a hater? I hate what you did, but I don't hate you.

CAMPBELL

Well, everyone else does. And they should.

RANDALL

AW, c'mon. But that was, like, such an *inept* lie. Which sorta speaks well of you in the long run.

CAMPBELL

Randall, what if I feel this awful for the rest of my life?

RANDALL

The rest of your life?

CAMPBELL

I don't see how it could get any worse.

RANDALL

I imagine a few people could make some suggestions.

(takes a deep breath)

Do you want some advice from someone your age, but who's way sager and wiser than you?

CAMPBELL

Sure.

#17 - Enjoy The Trip

RANDALL

I'M A STUD NOW, IT'S CLEAR,
SO IT'LL SHOCK YOU TO HEAR
THAT I WAS A TOTAL DORK
MY FRESHMAN YEAR —

CAMPBELL

You?

RANDALL

Right?

I WAS A LOSER, A MESS,
A LONER, DEPRESSED
THAT EVERY DAY I HAD TO BE ME
WALKED AROUND HOPING NO ONE WOULD SEE ME.

I'D LOCK MYSELF IN THE GUYS ROOM
AND LET THE TEARS FALL,
TIL ONE DAY THIS CUSTODIAN
KNOCKED ON MY STALL
AND ASKED IF I'D HEARD
OF THE BAND THE GRATEFUL DEAD
AND I THOUGHT HE MIGHT NOT BE
QUITE RIGHT IN THE HEAD,
BUT HE CHANGED MY LIFE AROUND WHEN HE SAID:

"RIGHT NOW EVERYTHING SEEMS SO IMPORTANT
BUT TIME RUSHES BY AT A CLIP.

CAMPBELL

But it's such a long blip!

RANDALL

That's what I said! He said:

"TRUST ME ON THIS, WHEN YOU'RE OLDER AND WISER AND BALDER AND FATTER

(RANDALL)

AND YOU LOOK BACK ON THIS MOMENT IN TIME
THE ONLY THING THAT'S GONNA MATTER IS,
DID YOU ONLY DO
WHAT YOU THOUGHT YOU SHOULD DO?
DID YOU DANCE MONKEY DANCE
CAUSE THE MAN TOLD YOU TO?
OR DID YOU SPEND YOUR TIME DOING
WHAT BRINGS JOY TO YOU?

"ALL YOU SEE IS THIS OLD DUDE
WITH A BROOM IN HIS HAND,
BUT I'VE FOLLOWED MY DREAMS
AND MY FAVORITE BAND.
SO DON'T SIT ON YOUR ASS
WAITING FOR LIFE TO BEGIN
IF YOU DO WHAT YOU LOVE
WITH YOUR TIME, THEN YOU WIN!
WHAT A LONG, STRANGE, WONDERFUL

CAMPBELL

Why didn't someone tell me that seventeen years ago?

RANDALL

You had a lot on your plate. Babies usually do.

CAMPBELL

This may sound dumb: but my whole life I felt like I had this one shot. One lifetime as me. And I see so many people wasting all their potential. Just letting life go by. You know?

RANDALL

Sure.

and I don't want to be them. I don't want to look back and feel sorry when I'm old. So I fought it, I worked so hard, but my life just crumbled anyway.

RANDALL

And then you got all crazy.

CAMPBELL

I so did.

RANDALL

You know, I think life is way longer than it may feel right now.

CAMPBELL

That's scary.

RANDALL

Be grateful.

CAMPBELL

I don't know how to fix all this. I screwed up so bad.

RANDALL

Maybe you'll figure it out tomorrow. And for now, just take a look at that view. Just — look. Take a breath. And —

He gestures at the vista.

CAMPBELL

(taking it in, realizing)

It's - spectacular.

RANDALL

Despite any evidence to the contrary: so are you. Know that.

CAMPBELL

And you.

RANDALL

(offering his hand)

Take a breath.

CAMPBELL

(taking it)

Take a breath.

They take a breath together.

RANDALL & CAMPBELL

(sing)

AND WHEN WE LOOK BACK,
THESE HIGH SCHOOL YEARS
WILL BE NOTHING MORE THAN A BLIP—
JUST A TALE TO TELL
THAT RINGS A BELL
SO WHAT THE HELL! WE MIGHT AS WELL ENJOY THE TRIP!

Campbell grabs Randall in a hug.

SCENE SEVEN EVA'S BEDROOM

#17a - To Eva's Room

Eva I-chats with Skylar and Kylar.

SKYLAR

So THEN I heard that Campbell and Danielle got into this girls-gone-wild catfight in the hallway.

EVA

No!

SKYLAR

Hair extensions, acrylic nails scattered as far as the eye could see.

KYLAR

And then Danielle disbanded the squad.

EVA

What?

KYLAR

The Jackson cheerleading curse asserts itself once more.

SKYLAR

And by the way, Campbell's telling everyone that you destroyed her life.

KYLAR

Everyone. You. Her. Life. Destroyed.

EVA

She is? Well, of course she'd try to distract attention from her own crimes. The poor thing is desperate.

SKYLAR

She's not the girl I knew.

KYLAR

She's ruined.

EVA

It's so sad. You guys, I'm gonna sign off and pray for her.

SKYLAR

Oh good for you, honey. If I had a God I'd totally do the same thing.

EVA

Let's keep Campbell in our hearts. G'nite.

SKYLAR

Nite.

KYLAR

Nite.

EVA

G'nite.

Skylar and Kylar disappear. Eva kneels in prayer:

#18 - Killer Instinct

DEAR GOD UP IN HEAVEN,
A PRAYER FOR CAMPBELL:
ONCE SHE WAS MY HERO,
NOW SHE'S A DISGRACE.

I'M HERE ON TOP

AND SHE'S LESS THAN ZERO,

DRAGGING ME DOWN – TO SAVE FACE.

SHE ALWAYS WORKED HARD,
SHE WAS TRUSTING AND FAIR,
AND LORD, THAT'S THE CRUX
OF HER PROBLEM RIGHT THERE.

YOU NEED THAT KILLER INSTINCT
TO GIVE YOU THE NERVE
TO GRAB EVERYTHING YOU WANT IN LIFE
BUT MAY NOT DESERVE.
LIKE, IF SOME GIRL'S IN YOUR WAY
THERE'S ONLY ONE THING TO DO:

YOU BLACKMAIL YOUR MOTHER
WHO SITS ON THE SCHOOL BOARD
TO GET CAMPBELL TRANSFERRED
AND RIPPED FROM THE LIFE THAT SHE KNEW –

EVA (and BACKUPS)

YOUR DREAMS COME TRUE!
AND YOUR DREAMS COME TRUE!
YOUR DREAMS COME TRUE-UE!

IT TAKES THAT KILLER INSTINCT, THAT KILLER DESIRE—
ARE YOU THE LITTLE ANT OR DO YOU SET THE ANTS ON FIRE?
AND IF THERE'S TWO GIRLS IN LINE
TO LEAD THE TEAM BEFORE YOU —

THEN YOU HACK THE SCHOOL'S SYSTEM AND CHANGE SKYLAR'S GRADE FROM A "D" TO AN "F"
THEN YOU HIRE SOME SICK GUY TO LICK KYLAR'S TOOTHBRUSH SO SHE CONTRACTS MONO
NOW NO ONE IS LEFT TO BE CAPTAIN SO THEY TURN TO YOU!
AND YOUR DREAMS COME TRUE!

BACKUP CHORUS

DREAMS COME TRUE – THEY DO, YEAH YEEAH –

EVA

DO I SOUND AWFUL?
WHAT HAVE I BECOME?
WHO'S THAT GIRL IN THE MIRROR I SEE?
SOME BACK-STABBING WACK JOB
I'D RUN SCREAMING FROM
OH GOD! I JUST LOVE BEING ME!
WOULDN'T ALL OF YOU KILL TO BE ME?!

ENSEMBLE

AWWW, SHIT!

EVA

YOU NEED THAT KILLER INSTINCT
SINCE TIME FIRST BEGAN
FROM GENGHIS KAHN TO BRISTOL PALIN
YOU NEED A KILLER PLAN.
YOU NEED TO REACH THE TOP
IF IT'S THE LAST THING YOU DO!

(EVA)

I'M THE GIRL TO BEAT!
THE HIGH SCHOOL QUEEN!
SENIORS KISS MY ASS
AND I'M JUST FIFTEEN!

BACKUPS

AND SOON THE WORLD WILL KNOW HER NAME!

EVA

I'M RAISIN HELL N'
I'M A FELON
IN A FOUR FOOT FRAME!

EVA (with BACKUPS)

I JUST USE MY KILLER INSTINCT AND MY DREAMS COME TRUE! I USE MY KILLER INSTINCT

ENSEMBLE

KILLER! INSTINCT!

EVA

(catches breath)

-UE! OH YEAH!

#18a - Killer Instinct (Playoff) / My Hickey!

ENSEMBLE

YOUR DREAMS COME TRUE!
AND YOUR DREAMS COME TRUE!
YOUR DREAMS COME TRUE!
THEY DO, YEAH YEAH!

YOUR DREAMS COME TRUE!
AND YOUR DREAMS COME TRUE,
JUST USE YOUR KILLER INSTINCT!

SCENE EIGHT HALLWAY AT JACKSON

Bridget and Twig enter with Nautica and La Cienega.

BRIDGET

Okay. Why am I wearing this turtleneck, you all must be wondering.

NAUTICA

Wondering what?

LA CIENEGA

Turtleneck? What huh?

BRIDGET

Please don't mention this to anyone, but I'm really super embarrassed by -

(pulls her collar down, nonchalant)

-my hickey.

LA CIENEGA

Girl! That thing needs its own zip code!

TWIG

I'm like Jackson Pollock with suction.

Campbell enters and meekly tries to hail Danielle.

CAMPBELL

Danielle - can we talk?

DANIELLE

Oh, is this the part where you make yourself feel better and we hug? What a shame it ain't gonna happen.

CAMERON

Baby, come on now! You made your point -

DANIELLE

This is between me and that one.

(taking a step toward Campbell)

You know, it takes a lotta nerve

Bridget intervenes.

BRIDGET

Stop it! I think we've all hated on Campbell enough for this month. At the top of next month we can start back up.

DANIELLE

Don't tell me to stop it -

BRIDGET

Don't mess. If you're gonna go all scrappin' with my dawg, all up in her shizzle, you gots to go through me. And byatch, I can lay down. Throw down. I can throw it down? How do you put that. Anyway, watch it, hater.

La Cienega's been recording on her cell phone.

LA CIENEGA

We already got 40,000 hits!

CAMPBELL

Look, can we talk if I promise to never bug you again?

DANIELLE

And what good are your promises?

(relenting)

Okay, you get sixty seconds so Miss Bridget stays outta my grill.

CAMPBELL

Can we talk alone?

DANIELLE

Fine. Alone.

Everyone else remains. Danielle turns to them.

y'all have a five count. Five, four, three

The others scramble off.

CAMPBELL

Um. Danielle, there might be words to say how sorry I am, but I don't think they make them in English. If I ever make a friend again, I'll be so true to them because I know, now — I know better. But that lesson came at your expense. I crossed the line and took advantage and I'm so, so sorry. Forever.

(a moment)

I guess my time is up.

A moment. Campbell turns to go.

DANIELLE

You could have just come to me, y'know, before you lied. I'd've helped you. You ruined something really special.

I'm so sorry.

DANIELLE

We covered the sorry, okay? I get it. Look –

#19 - We're Not Done

IT'S EASY TO IGNORE YOU
WHEN I SEE YOU DOWN THE HALL.
IT'S EASY TO BE ANGRY.
IT'S EASY NOT TO CALL.
TO THROW AWAY THIS THING WE HAD
AND BLAME IT ALL ON YOU
IT'S HARDER TO ADMIT I MISS IT TOO.

IT'S HARD WHEN I COME UP WITH SOMETHING NEW
AND I CAN'T SHOW YOU
IT'S HARD TO SEE YOU SUFFERING
IT'S HARD BECAUSE I KNOW YOU
IT'S HARD TO FIND FORGIVENESS
WE'VE SAID ALL THERE IS TO SAY.
WHAT SUCKS IS I DON'T SEE ANOTHER WAY.

CAMPBELL

I miss working together, all of us laughing at practice. I miss you. But I think about myself then, and it's like looking back at a whole other person. I kinda feel bad for her.

DANIELLE

What do you mean?

I woke up this morning and that *ambition* — it wasn't in me any more. For that trophy. I'm not sure I recognize myself now. And it's kind of okay. Scary. But okay.

A moment. Danielle puts out her hand.

DANIELLE

Hi. I'm Danielle. I don't think we've met.

CAMPBELL

Campbell. Hey.

A shy moment.

So what happens to us now?

DANIELLE

WE COULD JUST WAIT TO GRADUATE
AND LET THE YEAR GO BY
OR FINISH WHAT WE STARTED—
LET'S DO THIS, YOU

DANIELLE & CAMPBELL

AND I.

CAMPBELL

Do you mean -?

DANIELLE

WHEN THEY FINALLY PLAY OUR SONG -

CAMPBELL

IMAGINE THE LIGHTS

DANIELLE

AND WE MOVE IN PERFECT TIME -

CAMPBELL

IN THE MIDDLE OF THE CROWD-

DANIELLE

WE'RE IN THE POCKET AND NO ONE CAN STOP IT, WE'RE NOT GONNA DROP —

DANIELLE & CAMPBELL

AND WHEN WE ROCK IT, NOBODY CAN TOP IT, WE'RE NOT GONNA STOP 'TIL WE FLY!

WE'RE NOT DONE -

DANIELLE & CAMPBELL

'TIL WE FLY -

CAMPBELL

WE'RE NOT DONE -

DANIELLE & CAMPBELL

'TIL WE FLY -

WE'RE NOT DONE!

SCENE NINE NATIONAL CHEERLEADING COMPETITION

#20 – Legendary

ANNOUNCER

Ladies and gentlemen! Next on the mat here at Nationals — you've been waiting all day to see them — give it up for Truman High School!!

We watch Truman's entire routine. The squad is terrific.

SINGER

NOW IS OUR TIME,
THIS IS OUR MOMENT,
WE GOT HERE BY NOT KNOWING
WHAT THE WORD 'NO' MEANT.
YEARS FROM NOW WHEN THEY ASK YOU

TRUMAN SQUAD

HERE WE GO, HERE WE GO -

SINGER

(SINGER)

NO APPLAUSE IS NECESSARY
THIS ROUTINE IS

LEGENDARY!

(I CAN SEE YOU STARE AT ME)

LEGENDARY!

(I KNOW THAT YOU'RE OBSESSED)

LEGENDARY!

(KEEP YOUR EYES ON MY ROUTINE)

LEGENDARY!

I DON'T CHEER WITH MY CHEST!

TRUMAN SQUAD

WE'RE LOUD!

WE'RE TOUGH!

WE'RE RIGHT HERE IN YOUR FACE!

RING *RING* HELLO?

OH HOLD ON. IT'S FOR YOU:

IT'S SECOND PLACE!

SINGER

WE GOT THE SOUL -

TRUMAN SQUAD

HEY!

SINGER

DETERMINATION -

TRUMAN SQUAD

HO!

SINGER

TO BE THE LEADERS

OF THIS HERE CHEER NATION!

TRUMAN SQUAD

HERE WE GO! HERE WE GO! HERE WE GO!

SINGER

THINK OF THIS SPANKING

AS YOUR EDUCATION!

I THINK WE JUST POPPED OUR CHERRY -

THIS ROUTINE IS-

TRUMAN SQUAD

TRUMAN'S WHAT?

SINGER

SOUL-SHAKING!

TRUMAN SQUAD

TRUMAN'S WHAT?

SINGER

GROUNDBREAKING!

TRUMAN SQUAD

THIS IS WHAT?

SINGER

PRIZE-TAKING!

HISTORY IN THE MAKING! (4X)

LEGENDARY!

(I CAN SEE YOU STARE AT ME)

LEGENDARY!

(I KNOW THAT YOU'RE OBSESSED)

LEGENDARY!

(KEEP YOUR EYES ON MY ROUTINE)

LEGENDARY!

I DON'T CHEER WITH MY CHEST

LEGENDARY!

Truman exults as the scene transits to...

SCENE TEN THE HOLDING AREA

#20a - Truman Rocks!

ANNOUNCER

(muffled, off)

And hailing from Coos Bay, Oregon, next up is Marshfield High School! Give it up, ladies and gentlemen!

EVA

You guys! I did so good!

KYLAR

Hello - ??

SKYLAR

We ALL "did so good"

EVA

But I get to hold the trophy. Don't forget. And talk to the media. And -

ANNOUNCER

Jackson High School. Jackson, you're on deck.

Campbell enters. Dramatic sting as Eva sees her.

EVA

You.

CAMPBELL

Me.

EVA

What are you doing here, dressed like that?

CAMPBELL

I'm trick-or-treating, Eva. Great work out there.

She goes to Skylar, Kylar, and the rest of the Truman squad.

You guys were amazeballs!

KYLAR

Hey Campbell!

SKYLAR

Thanks girl!

EVA

So your squad's gonna compete. Even after what you did.

CAMPBELL

Oh, we're in this.

EVA

(taking hold of Campbell's uniform)

Well, I hear you're telling people that I screwed you over. Maybe we should clear the air so you can compete without all that, y'know, negative stuff floating around.

Danielle approaches, listening.

CAMPBELL

Well if you didn't screw me over then I apologize.

EVA

Apology accepted.

CAMPBELL

I'm glad I went through all that whether we win or not.

EVA

So "it's not about the winning." Be careful 'cause only the losers say that. Maybe you should needlepoint that on a throw pillow and scoot your bottom over to the holding area. You're on deck.

DANIELLE

Campbell — this a friend of yours?

CAMPBELL

Oh Danielle you MUST meet Eva -

EVA

(to Danielle)
